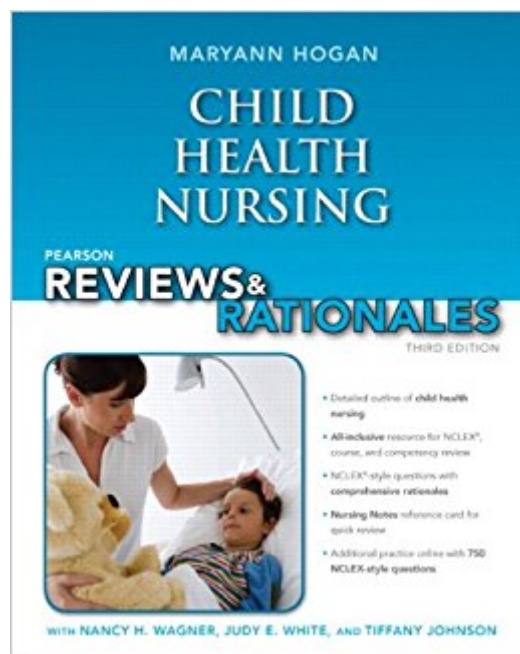

I bought this right before my first peds exam in nursing school, and was shocked when I received an A! (I always do pretty horrible on the first exam of the semester) In my opinion, this book does a really great job of summarizing the topic, and wherever there was an "NCLEX Alert", it seemed to be something my instructors wrote a question about. The review questions at the end of each chapter were very similar to the ones I saw on my exam, and the rationales really helped me see why each answer was correct. I felt like it gave me a much better perspective of thinking while I was taking my exam.
