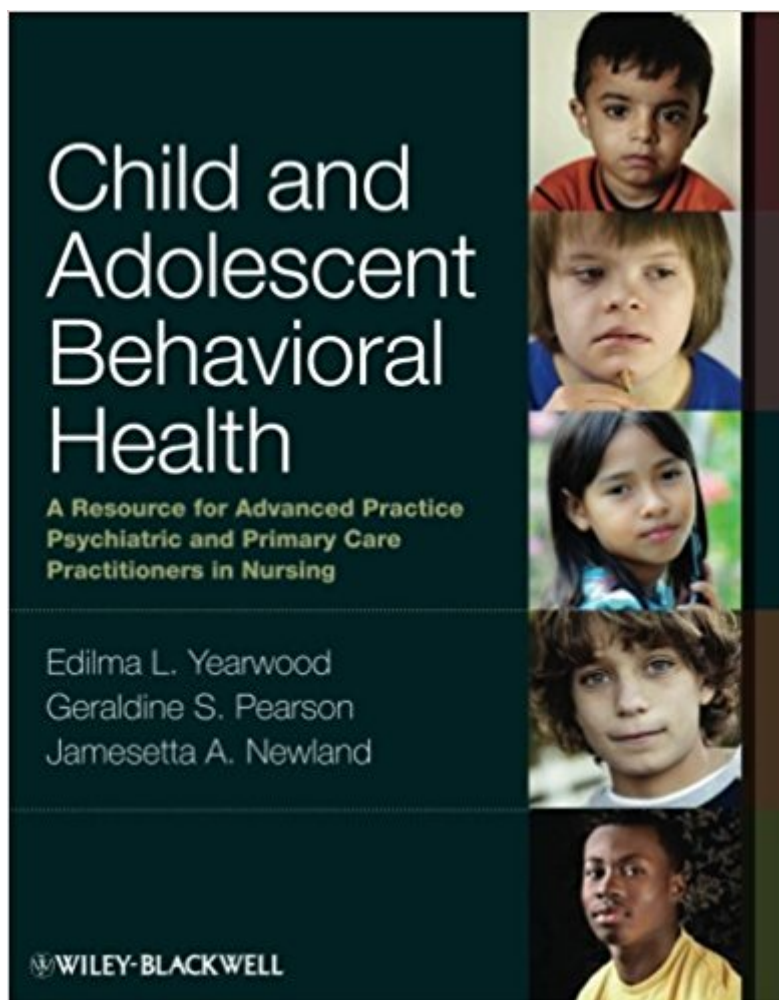




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# Child And Adolescent Behavioral Health: A Resource For Advanced Practice Psychiatric And Primary Care Practitioners In Nursing
