

This book is a Christmas present for my daughter who is a huge Grimm fan. She will love it! The book is gorgeous and beautifully detailed. One caveat- the pictures really are like those on the show so young children may be disturbed if they flip through this.

Then you will enjoy this book. Just imagine that the stories you read as a kid actually described real beings and their interactions with humans. Fun, huh? And more than a bit scary. This book is a companion book of sorts to the television story of a modern descendent of the Brothers Grimm - a police detective in Portland, Oregon. He discovers that certain members of his family, himself included, can actually see these Wesen, or members of the fairy tale creatures community. The book is a replica of one of the books handed down in his family and it contains drawings and information about some of these beings. Some of it is written in German, some in Latin, Spanish and English. All of the texts, as far as I can tell, are translated into English. I find it fun and I like to have it with me when I watch the program, so that I can look up the creatures along with the detective. I enjoy it and hope you will as well.

For what it covers it's a pretty good book, but there are so many creatures that the book doesn't cover that I was a bit disappointed in it. It skips right over the Fuchbaus and many others. If you are looking for a book that covers all of the Grimm creatures, keep looking. Don't get me wrong, the artwork and presentation are top notch, but it's not complete.

This book has similar illustrations like what you have seen on tv. But it contains only the most common ones, or the ones that were in the first/second season. It does not have all the illustrations. But Aunt Marie had several books, maybe this is just the first one....I still enjoy reading and browsing it.
