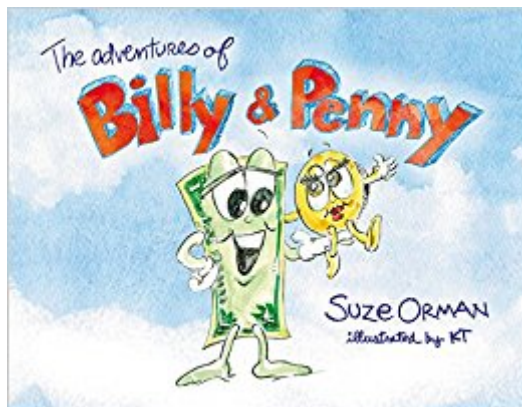

I'm a big fan of Suze Orman. So I had high expectations for this book, and unfortunately, it was a disappointment. The drawings looked like sketches that had not yet been fully colored in. The wording was way too long for any child under about age 9 or 10. However, the biggest negative about the book was that the plot just wasn't great. It seemed to only teach that money disappears with little information about its value other than pennies matter. I think it's much more important to teach children the value of a dollar rather than every penny counting, since really pennies don't count very much at all. As a side note, the male dollar being worth 100 times more than the female penny had poor gender implications. We returned the one we purchased.
