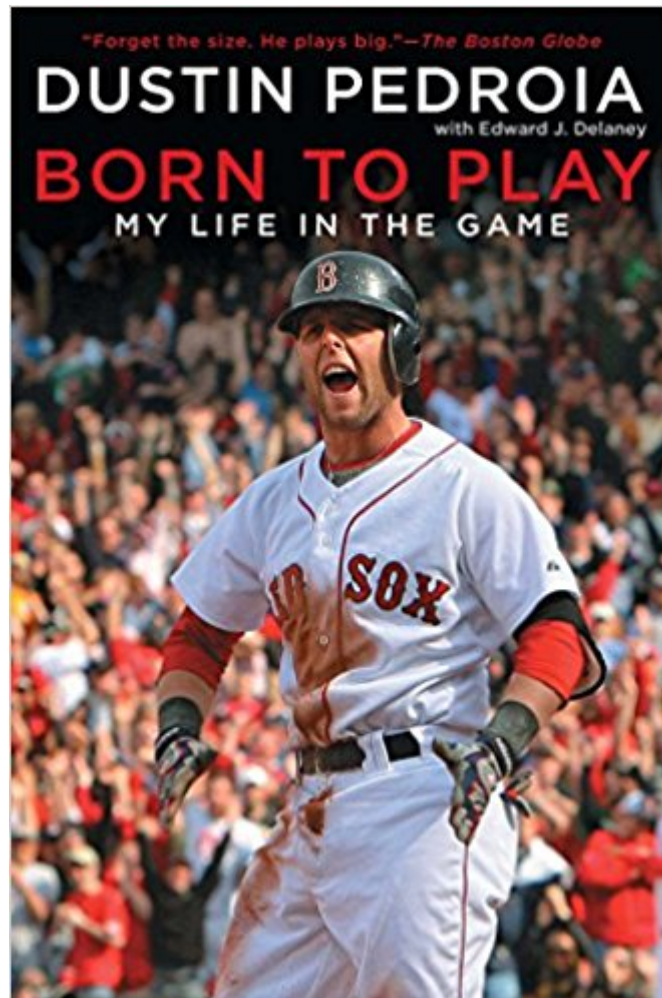

During his brief career in the majors, Dustin Pedroia has already won several awards including being named the 2007 American League Rookie of the Year and the 2008 American League MVP. Pedroia ended the 2008 season with a .326 average with 17 home runs, 83 RBIs, and 20 stolen bases. He was tied for the MLB in hits with 213 and led the league in doubles (54), while leading the AL in runs scored (118). In December 2008, Pedroia signed a six-year contract extension with the Red Sox.

I am fascinated by Dustin Pedroia as a player and discovered that I would really like him as a person. Although the book was not in good condition when I got it, it was obvious that the original owner really used the book a lot. It is well worth the time to read it if you are interested the experiences of a young man learning to play baseball and his experiences in trying to reach the major leagues. I am a baseball fan and have read several books about baseball and I consider this one a fine story. Each chapter is separated with a page or two of comments from people who knew Dusty during his rise to become the backbone of the Red Sox. He was given a long term contract with the Red Sox and has said that he will spend his entire career with them - like Derek Jeter with the Yankees. Dusty is always the first player to arrive for practice and for games, and he really enjoys the game. He and his wife and two sons live in Arizona in the winter so that he can work out and play baseball all winter, and they live in the Boston area in the summer. He really likes Boston and the Fenway Baseball Stadium.

I'm really disappointed in this book. I bought it for my son to read as he is of small stature and loves playing baseball. However the foul language peppered liberally through the pages is off putting at best. I'm going to finish it, to see if there is something my son can get from the book that will make it worth the read, but I guess I'll just look around for a biography instead. A shame.

You don't have to be Red Sox fan to respect and admire Dustin Pedro's work ethic and values. He is what we should all strive to be. Not a baseball player but a never say die personality. Great book if you're like stories of the little guy with a never quit and never give up attitude who comes out on top.
