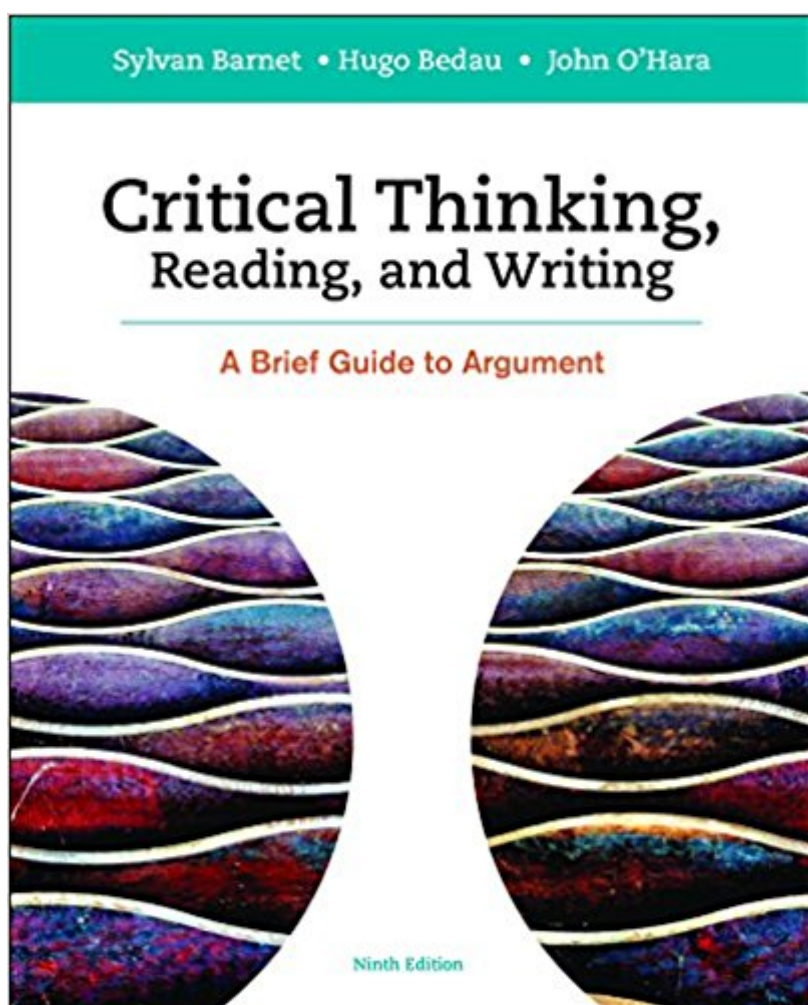

Dreadful. In a painful attempt to be topical, the authors choose as many controversial topics as they can find. The bias of the authors against those who believe in objective truth comes through loud and clear in example after example and page after page. Belief is a bad thing and inimical to critical

thought, is the obvious message. Pornography of all kinds is discussed in detail, and presented as a riveting topic (and you're never done with it, in this book), as is gay marriage and drug use. The group which calls itself "the Church of the Flying Spaghetti Monster" is given ample airtime by these authors, all in the name of learning about argument and critical thought. The promotional photograph for Desperate Housewives is also featured with the caption ". . . long-running ABC television series . . . which dramatized the furtive sex lives and exploits of suburban women . . . " In the section entitled, "Are some images not fit to be shown?" there are several photographs which are not fit to be shown, including people being executed, fire victims falling to their deaths while partially clad, and of course we all need to see (again) the photo of the Vietnamese children running in terror. There is a recipe based on dog meat, because these authors just happen to think it makes an interesting example. The writers of these books place themselves on a pedestal, as experts in argument and logic, but they debase themselves by exploring every lurid and 'topical' topic in the name of "critical thinking." Think twice about any course that uses this uninspired book as a resource. If you must purchase it, buy an older edition second hand, because you'll want to garbage it when you're through.
