

Brewster was the dean of the medical school for 2+ years in 2007-2009. This historical review, written in a rather dry medical journal style, gives a thorough overview of the Fiji School of medicine. It starts in 1885 with the native doctors and goes on to the current school, which graduates 60-70 MB BS students per annum. He gives an excellent overview of modern medical teaching theory, with emphasis on problem based learning. Worth reading if you are coming to Fiji for a medical stint and you want a background including politics and historical facts.
