

## Synopsis

Regan Hamilton Madison is perfect. She's gorgeous ("a knockout with those full, luscious lips, to say nothing about the soft curves and long legs") but doesn't seem to be aware of it. She's rich (her family owns a hotel empire), but as head of her family's foundation, she spends her time giving money away. She even drives an old car. She doesn't have a boyfriend, but she does have a stalker, a psychopath bent on killing her. Enter Alec Buchanan, a smart detective who just happens to be perfect himself. He's gorgeous, "scruffy&#x85;sexy&#x85;he had impeccable manners, was obviously well-educated, and had a sense of humor." And he doesn't have a lover either. Regan draws up the titular murder list at the request of a guru/messiah who preys on "rich but lonely vulnerable women" (it's supposed to be cathartic) and who is the villain of a subplot. Although Regan is much too nice to want to murder anybody, she whimsically makes a list of the people she'd like to remove from her radar screen. When the people on Regan's list begin to die, though, the plot moves into high gear. By that time the reader is pages ahead of the clearly telegraphed plot developments, and even the real mysteries&#x97;why Regan? who is the psycho killer?&#x97;are solved by the reader long before the characters see the light. Bestseller Garwood (Killjoy, etc.) has her shining moments, but she serves up a predictable woman-in-peril suspense novel this time around. As Alec guards Regan, she receives a text on her phone showing the face of the dead detective Sweeney and soon after, she remembers the man in the rain when she dropped all her items. When she tells Alec, he is livid with her because deep down, he is fighting his attraction for the beautiful Regan and his goals at the same time by leaving Chicago for good. As Regan confronts her own feelings for Alec, more murders are committed on her murder list and she is torn between doing what is right and the love of a man she knows she can't hold back. The surprising element was actually the real motive behind the killings and who the real mastermind is. Ms Garwood has excelled in creating this story.

One of my favorites. This story is about another Buchanan, Alex. It also is the first of three stories for three extremely close friends. In typical Garwood style, the characterization is spot on and tension is high. With the varioys little comic relief moments through out, it is another winner.

I got this as a Kindle promo, not knowing anything about the author or her home genre.I have to say I enjoyed the first part of the book. I thought the device of going to Regan's first day of Kindergarten then flash forwarding was interesting and well done.On the other hand, minor nits started piling up for me until they started to take over what I was supposed to be reading. The drug bust left me wondering what happened. The way the resignation of one of the main characters didn't seem to be handled realistically to me and catapulted me out of the story. Then having the cop serve as bodyguard was similarly jolting...I don't think a real PD would have countenanced such a thing and

yes, this is fiction...but to suspend disbelief the suspension requires a little plausibility. It's not Agatha Christie, but then it's not a horrible read either. It's good for a monitary pleasant diversion, but I don't think I'll be re-reading it again, unfortunately.

I strongly recommend this book and series. Love the families and friends, this is one of the best in the series. Can't wait for more.

The series continues with another compelling story with this fourth book. There is a perfect pitch between the romantic and suspense elements and it moves quickly. I also liked the added "girlfriends" component of the storyline, providing the main character, Regan Madison, with realistic dimensions. Alec Buchanan is nicely defined as her love interest along with others from the Chicago Police Department to flesh out his role. Regan's brothers could be better developed but overall, this is a good story, one I highly recommend.

I like some of Julie Garwood's writing, but this book was awful. I never once felt any connection to the characters. Not that they weren't likeable, but the way the story was told was cold, there just wasn't any depth. The author tried to communicate the depth of the main characters' feelings for each other by repeating lines multiple times but I wasn't buying it. I have paid \$3 for books I enjoyed much more that were written in a way the reader could connect and get lost in the story.

Ms Garwood is a good story teller, but her writing is somewhat amateurish. The fact that she has been on the NY Times best seller list so many times makes me wonder why. Her writing seems to lack research and real life experience. For example, she apparently was never in a walking or running race. It's very hard to get so far away from the pack that no one can see you. It appears she needs to decide if she wants to write murder mysteries or romance novels. Spending four or five chapters on a sex scene turned into sheer drivel.
