

I own about ten songbooks for the ukulele, but this one is my very favorite. The author is a true ukulele enthusiast, and that comes across in all of his books, but there is something special and endearing about this particular book. The Beatle's "When I'm Sixty Four" is surprisingly easy to learn on the ukulele and it is upbeat and kind of funny -- just like a good ukulele performance should be. "Here Comes the Sun" is absolutely beautiful on the ukulele and my all-time ukulele favorite.

"Michelle" sounds amazing, but it sure is difficult to learn. The book is a collection of easy, medium, and difficult songs to keep you busy for years. The introduction by George Harrison adds to the fun of being a part of ukulele culture. This was one of my first ukulele books, and I give it much credit for making me into the ukulele enthusiast I am today. If you want to make a ukulele player smile, buy him or her this book!

I agree with other beginner Uke players. I have played a cornet (Bb brass) for a long time, but no piano/stringed instrument experience. Been playing the uke for about a month - learned a few basic chords and simple strum patterns. Most of the songs in here are a bit above my pay grade right now. Not to worry - good to have some goals, right? The printing quality etc is very good with a good selection of 60's favorites, so no doubt it will get some use as my skills improve. Will maybe buy something from Jumping Jim which has more immediate play-ability for me.

it's ok but a lot of the chords are a bit too advanced for me and all are too high - not sure i'm up to the task of transposing every song. also, it's a bit heavy on beatles songs. no groovy flower child folk songs as the title would imply. i might try selling it to my local independent music store in exchange for a different book. oh well.

I like this song book. I like most of the songs in it and find them easy to play and sing along with since I am familiar with those songs. If you like this sort of music and play the Uke, you might enjoy this book too.

Chord diagrams are right over the lyrics so the songs are very easy to follow. It also provides a big chart of chords at the beginning of the book, the strings the uke are tuned to, and each song is provided with a diagram of the starting note. All very helpful and lots of fun!

This is a fantastic compilation of most of the popular songs in the 60s. Too bad it doesn't come with a CD. As a beginner, I aren't quite sure how to make out the strumming pattern by looking at the charts. But it's excellent if you are a better ukulele player.
