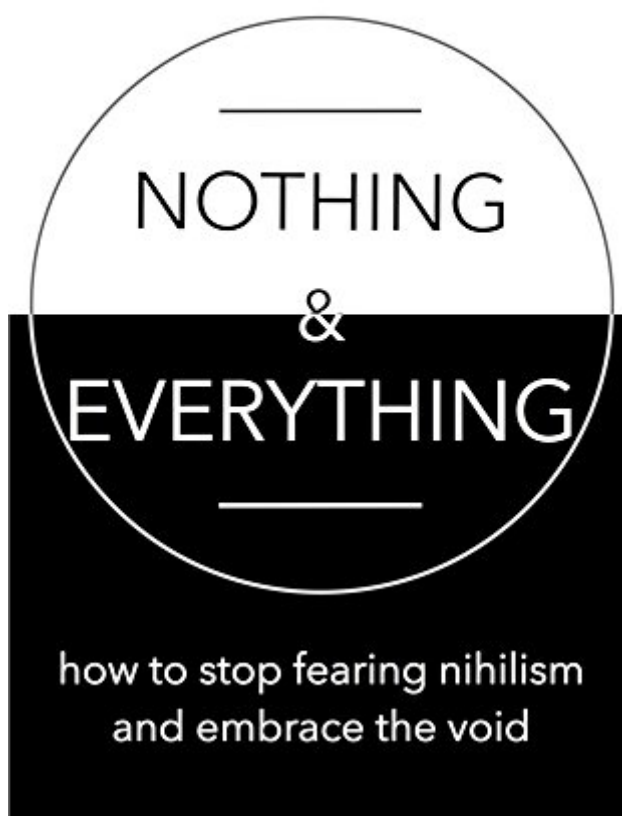


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Nothing & Everything: How To Stop Fearing Nihilism And Embrace The Void

This is one of the better books I have read on nihilism. It has quite a few formally structured arguments, but it basically boils down to tearing apart concrete thinking. Truth is relative and subjective which rips reason asunder. In the end we are stuck in a quandary and are forced to embrace some form of logic built on premises we can't prove. The book itself is a bit dry in the lengthy way he builds his arguments. A few spelling errors are present, but overall the kindle version of the book is well edited. The author also chose to use plain everyday speech, which makes it easier to read than other authors that show off their vast vocabulary of words rarely seen outside a dictionary.

This is not an easy read. Typical of a lot of philosophical writing it can be dense and demanding of the reader, but the pay off, if you complete the slog is so worth it. It is, truly, a work of liberation.

Well written with only a few typos. It deserves a second and maybe even a third or fourth reading. The author's description of creative nihilism is embraceable and not dogmatic. If you want to go down the rabbit hole and are willing to change how you view your relationship with the world then this is an excellent primer for doing so. I have read books on religion, classical philosophy, psychology, etc...and I am very pleased to have this as part of my " library". I now feel that it's reasonable that I will never discover any absolute and/or objective truth about reality and I've never felt happier or more tranquil about that idea!
