

American actor Vincent Price (1911Ã¢ ¬â œ93) was well known for his distinctive voice and serio-comic performances in horror films from the latter part of his career. He and his wife, costume designer Mary Grant Price (1917Ã¢ ¬â œ2002), were avid art collectors and gourmets.
