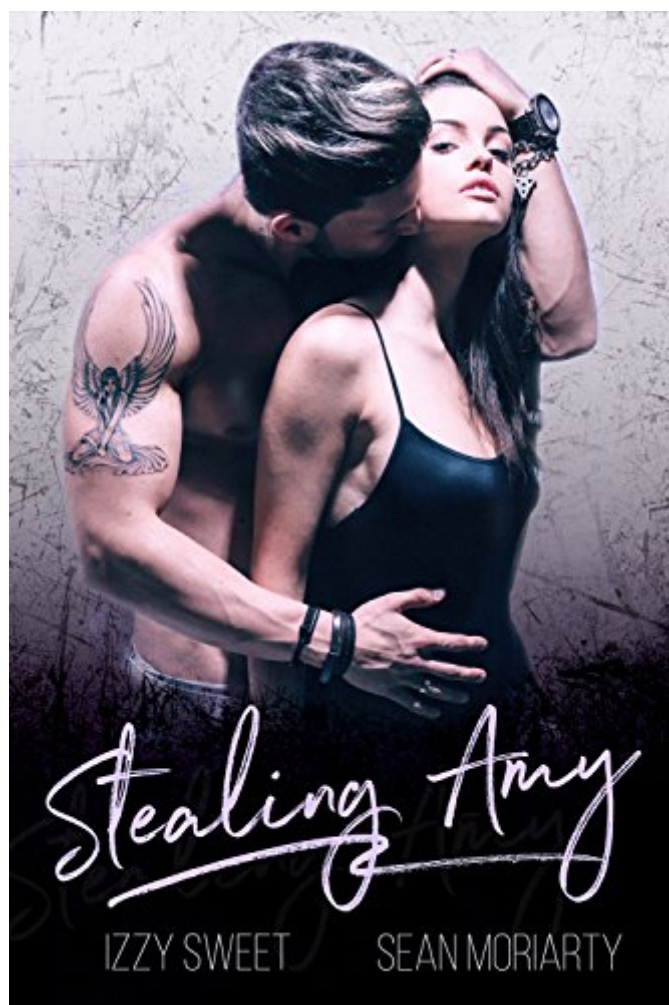


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Stealing Amy: A Dark Romance (Disciples Book 2)
