

Part of a 3-part apocalyptic series based loosely on Revelation. It is well written though I don't especially enjoy first person narrative. It seems perhaps aimed more at a high school level reader, the main characters being a teenage boy and his girlfriend, than an adult reader. The use of nano-technology and brain implants by the Devil in order to bring about his take-over of the world is actually quite clever, a new updated spin on the story. I won't go on and on. It's a novel take on a timeless story, well written, well developed characters. It's a light read but a good read.

Loved the pace of this book and loved the mix of religion, technology and YA. This book is for anyone who likes any of those three topics. While there is a lot to think about in this book, you don't have time! The main character is whizzing all over the world with his enemies not far behind him. You will always want to know what's next.
