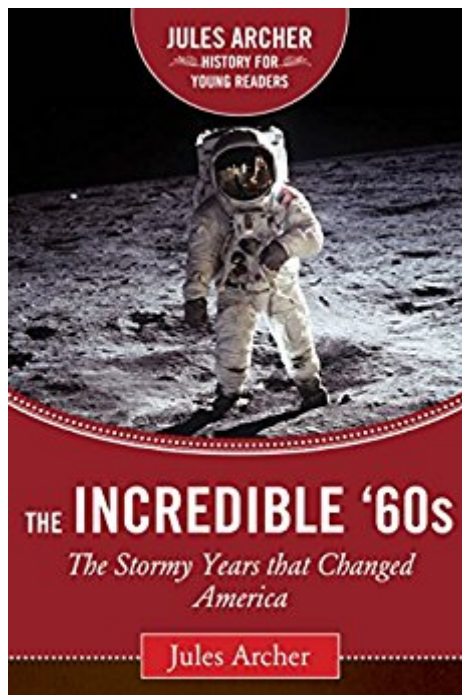




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The Incredible '60s: The Stormy Years That Changed America (Jules Archer History For Young Readers)
