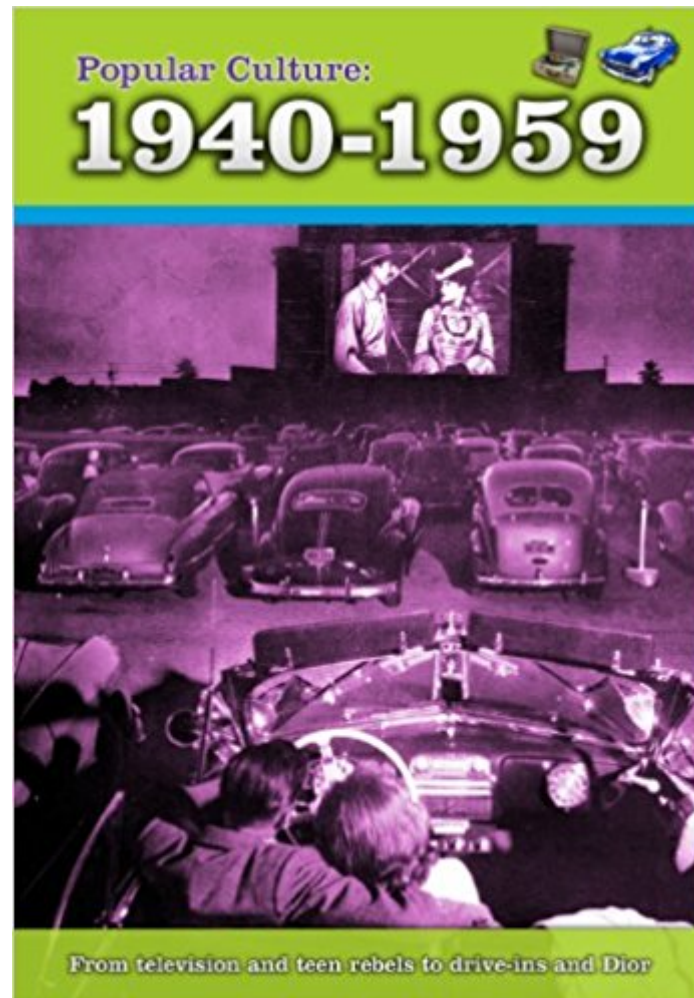




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Popular Culture: 1940-1959 (A History Of Popular Culture)
