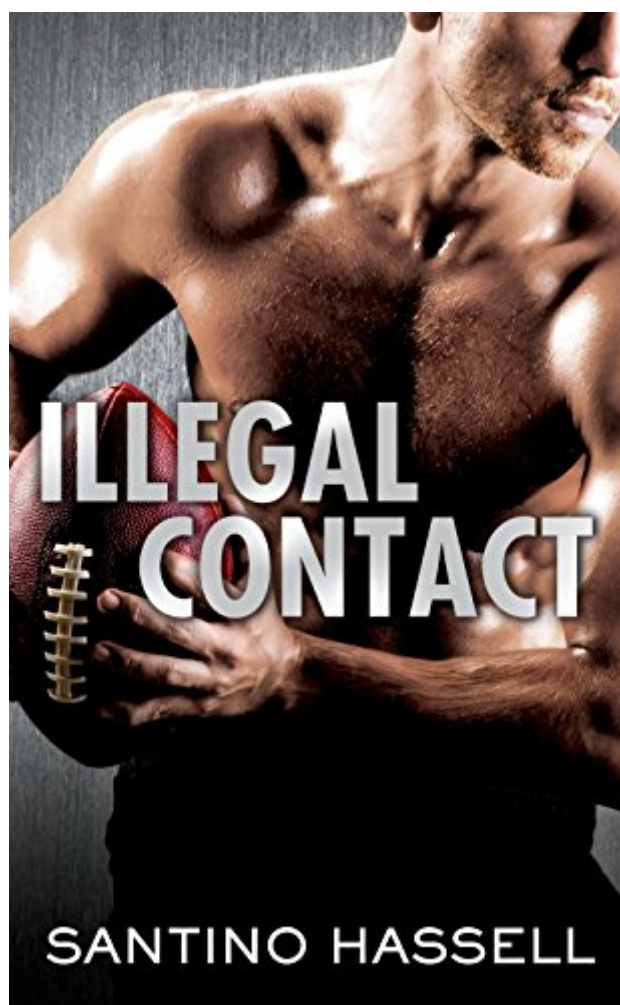

Great beginning to a new M/M series! In the past, the few books I have read in this genre have been

great. Maybe because I love the authors' other books or I was already invested in the characters getting together. Regardless of the reason, *Illegal Contact* must be included in my list of M/M favorites. Why? Well, the characters are memorable. The writing is wicked and the romance is hot! Gavin Brawley is the tight-end for the Barons, a New York's football team. He was suspended and is under house arrest for six months after he was caught on tape fighting. Gavin has a reputation for losing his cool easily but he doesn't seem to care about any of that except playing football. Completely different from his two friends, Simeon and Marcus, who are the golden kids of the team. Joe, Gavin's manager, knows Gavin needs a personal assistant at home to help him out. Gavin isn't crazy about the idea but in the end, he knows it is unavoidable. Noah Monroe has a mountain of student loans. He's looking for a job to help pay the bills and to help his father, who's currently unemployed. Noah has no idea about football. He couldn't care less about it and it shows in his first interview with Gavin and Joe. He's surprised when he actually gets the position. Noah knows he's going to butt heads with Gavin but he won't back down without a fight. What neither was counting on was in those pesky sparks igniting. Gavin and Noah were completely different people. Noah was the geeky cute guy, while Gavin was the strong athlete. It was interesting seeing how this two realized they did have a common ground after all. Gavin was able to show his softer side, while Noah learned that not every jock is dumb.
