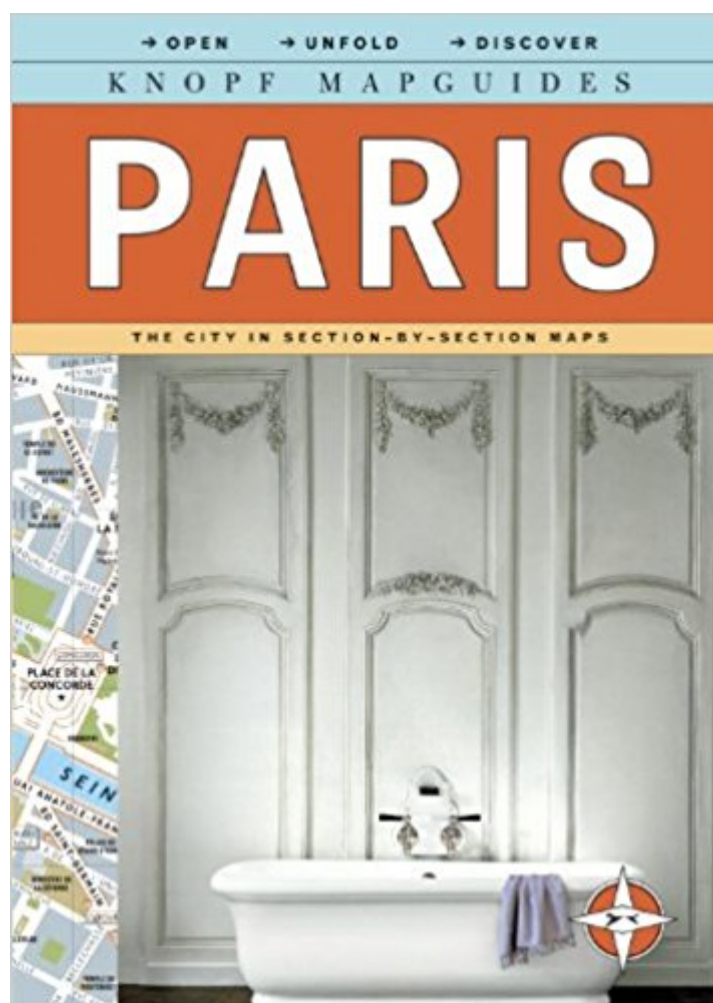

This opening fold-out contains a general map of Paris to help you visualize the 8 large districts discussed in this guide, and 4 pages of valuable information, handy tips and useful addresses. Discover Paris through 8 districts and 6 maps: Latin Quarter/ The islands/ Montparnasse/ Orsay/ Louvre/ Opera/ Les Halles/ Le Marais/ Invalides/ Champ-de-Mars/ Trocadero/ Grands Boulevards/ Montmartre/ Bastille/ Faubourg Saint-Antoine/ Oberkampf/ Menilmontant/ Belleville/ La Villette/ Place d'Alsace-Lorraine/ Bibliotheque Nationale/ Bercy. For each district there is a double-page of addresses (restaurants, cafés, bars, music venues and stores) followed by a fold-out map for the relevant area with the essential places to see (indicated on the map by a star *). These places are by no means all that Paris has to offer but to us they are unmissable. The grid-referencing system (A B2) makes it easy for you to pinpoint addresses quickly on the map. Transportation and hotels in Paris: The last fold-out consists of a transportation map and 4 pages of practical information that include a selection of hotels. A thematic index lists all the sites and addresses featured in this guide.

This book really simplifies your ability to move around an unfamiliar city like Paris. The book/map is divided by areas within the city, with a detailed fold-out map for each area that includes all the places of interest/restaurants/bars/shopping within each area. Practically all your trip planning is done for you! You just need to highlight & prioritize the spots you absolutely want to hit while in Paris, start walking, and take this book with you everywhere you go! It even includes a map of the metro system, so you can plan which metro lines to take to your next destination (if it's further than you want to walk). We hit some of the recommended restaurants that indicated were frequented by locals, and they were right on the mark! Some of the best food we had on our trip!!! I will definitely look into another Knopf MapGuide for any other major cities we plan to visit in the future!!!

I have an entire shelf of Paris books and maps. This product has proven to be the easiest to use when considering maps. Because you open sections of the city rather than the whole thing, the scale is larger and the map is easier to read. Very easy to flip back and forth from master map to neighborhood map to metro map. The written text and touring suggestions are not particularly good, so you'll need back-up for that, but this is worth having just for the maps. Recommended.

entire time. it even has metro map which helps. best features: small size, fits in coat pocket. each page folds out a particular section so you don't see entire map all at once, just the area you are in, the restaurants listed for each area are super helpful! we used several of them and were quite satisfied with their recommendations. if you get this map, you won't need another one for Paris.

This has also been to Paris a number of times with various people. The fold out maps are handy and the information is very well organized. Don't use it to find obscure addresses though.....you need a real map for that. Things to keep in mind when going to Paris:- Get your Museum Pass before you go! It will get you past all the lines!- You MUST visit Louis Vuitton on Champs Elysee. Anything you buy in Paris is eligible for VAT refund so why not brag that your handbag/wallet/keychain came from the historic store in Paris?- food is awesome.- French people are very well dressed and very polite despite popular opinion. I found everyone to be helpful and warm.

Spent a month in Paris recently, and loved the size and versatility of this guide. The foldout maps are just the right size to let you know how to get somewhere without being so large that you feel like you're wrestling with a sheet of newspaper. Not looking like Tommy Tourist is major part of enjoying Paris. You won't get hounded by the trinket sellers at the Eiffel Tower, and are less likely to get pick-pocketed around the Louvre. So a discreet guidebook is a must. P.S. Don't talk to the young kids with clipboards, and don't feel bad about being rude to them. They are pickpockets, and will scam you if you give them half an opportunity.

I borrowed a copy from a friend for my trip to Paris & it came in handy until I lost it. I ordered him another copy when I got home and got one for myself while I was at it. The maps are clear & easy to read. There is an overall map to give you perspective of the whole city, then smaller fold-out sections to enlarge specific neighborhoods. Plus, it's small & light enough to carry around with you while you explore.

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
