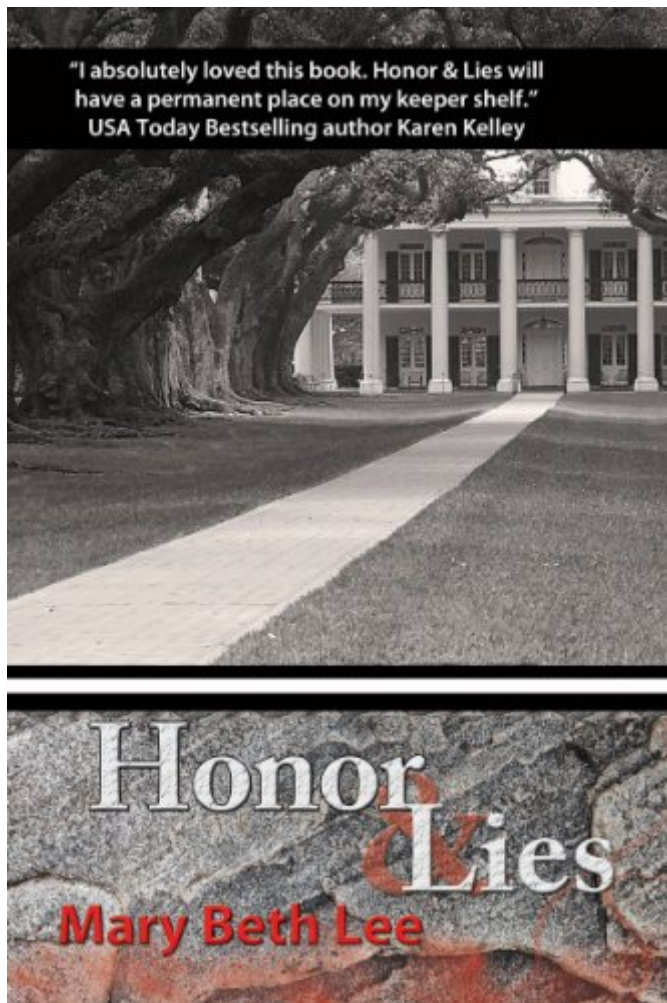


The book was found

Synopsis
