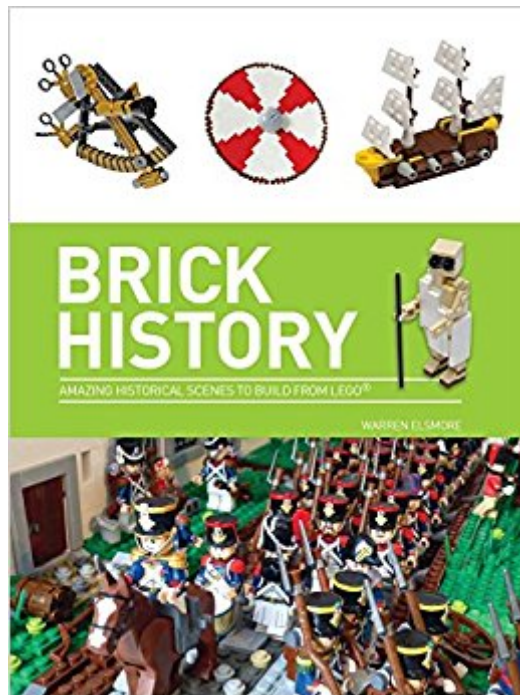

I have purchased every LEGO book by Warren Elsmore. For kids who might not otherwise take an interest in history, history becomes a lot more interesting when LEGOs are involved. Obviously, you won't get an in-depth history lesson from these books, but they are great for stirring an interest and presenting history in a way that kids who might not otherwise pay attention will remember. I've found Elsmore's other books to be educational in a similar way.
