

I find myself coming back to this book for a no-nonsense refresher on how I should be preparing my submission. I like that it breaks down what I need to write and how I need to write. Whereas the National Board prompts are abstruse and almost accusatory, this book reminds me of what I am already doing and walks me along the path of describing that practice in a way that the National Boards folks can understand.

I’m very glad that I purchased this book while working on Component 2 last year. I am certain that I would not have understood the prompts as well nor would I have been clear in my writing without referring to the helpful strategies in this book. It is short and to the point. I have just ordered the

"sequel" for Components 3 and 4.

I was struggling on how to get started with writing Component 2 for my National Boards. This book helped me get a handle on the expectations and type of writing that was needed. I know I did much better due to using this book.

You will not find a better resource out there for the NBCT process. It is clear, concise, and consistent...just like we are asked to do in our writing. You will refer to these books often to keep you on track!

This is a great reference to the NB, especially if you're feeling lost or overwhelmed. Faulkner gives great tips while still holding onto the integrity of the certificate. Glad I bought it!

I ordered this book when I was almost done with Components 1 and 2, so it helped some, but I wish I had ordered this much sooner. A Great Resource for someone just starting out on their National Board Journey!

All this booklet included were general test-taking tips and the same information about the components you can find on the national board website. If this is something that you feel would benefit you, don't bother wasting your money on attempting the national boards. Disclaimer: I only read the 8 pages dedicated to component 1, before putting this ineffectual guide down. I didn't bother reading the dozen or so pages dedicated to component 2. I have a hard time believing the author thought this would really benefit anyone attempting the national boards. It seems more like he or she saw an opportunity to make easy money off desperate individuals.
