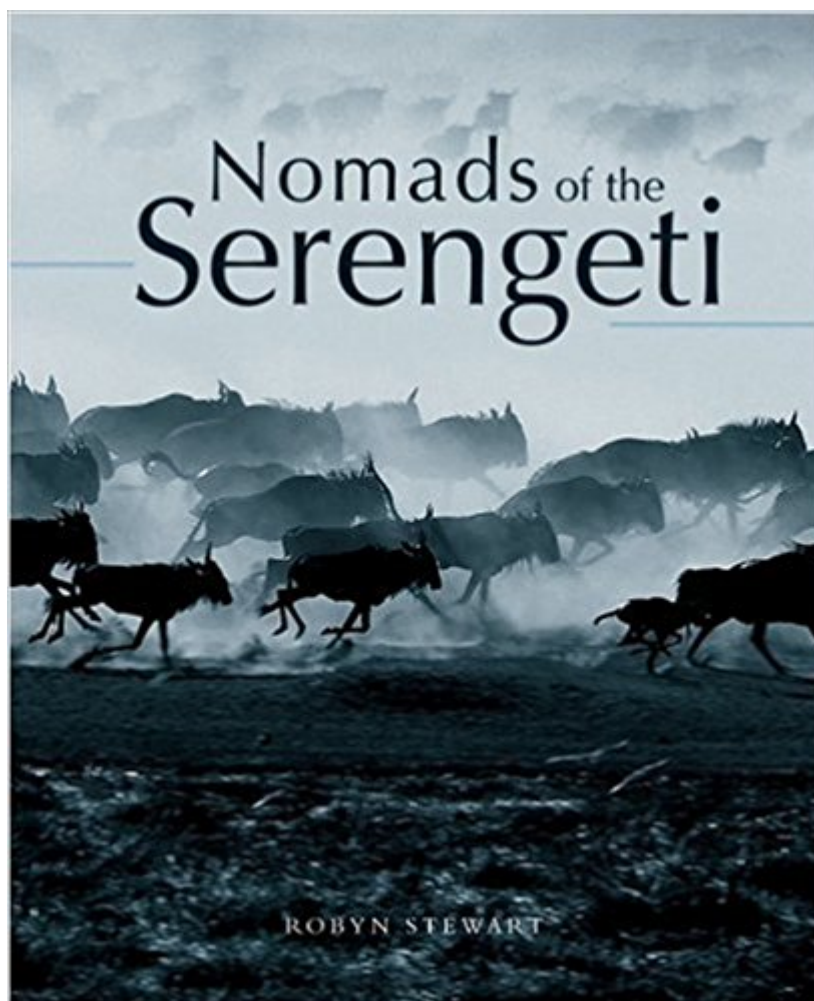


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Nomads Of The Serengeti

Robyn Stewart's *NOMADS OF THE SERENGETI* documents, using full-page color photos, the annual migration of wildlife which takes place yearly in Tanzania's Serengeti National Park. The different regions of the park are explored with a focus on large-herd migration patterns: any armchair reader who would learn about the park's wildlife and habits must have this.
