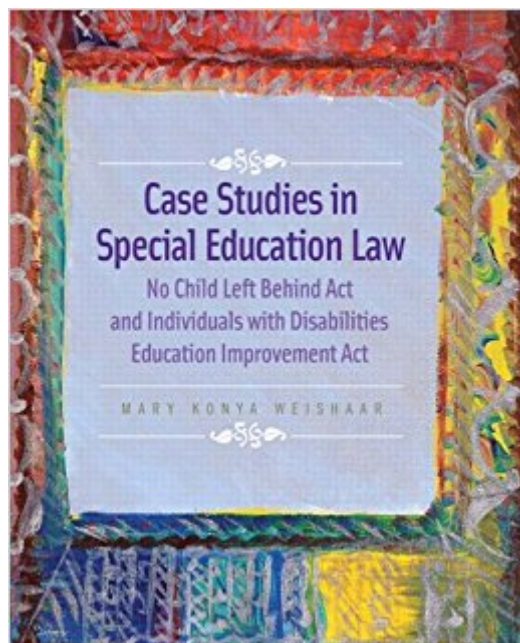




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Case Studies In Special Education Law: No Child Left Behind Act And Individuals With Disabilities Education Improvement Act
