

Rick Steves has spent 100 days every year since 1973 exploring Europe. Rick produces a public television series "(Rick Steves' Europe)," a public radio show "(Travel with Rick Steves)," and an app and podcast "(Rick Steves Audio Europe); " writes a bestselling series of guidebooks and a nationally syndicated newspaper column; organizes guided tours that take thousands of travelers to Europe annually; and offers an information-packed website (ricksteves.com). With the help of his hardworking staff of 80 at Europe Through the Back Door in Edmonds, Washington, just north of Seattle Rick's mission is to make European travel fun, affordable, and culturally broadening for Americans. Honza Vihan grew up roaming the Czech countryside in search of the Wild West. Once the borders opened, he set off for South Dakota. His journey took him to China, Honduras, India,

and Iran, where he contributed to several travel guides. Honza lives in Prague with his wife, studies for a PhD in Chinese, and leads Rick Steves' tours through Eastern Europe."

Great book and good tips from Rick Steves - saved at least 45 minutes of waiting in line at the castle by following his guidance.

What I liked best about this guide compared to others is the size. It is small and light enough to carry while sightseeing unlike some other guides I've bought in the past , like Fodor's which is very comprehensive but impossibly heavy to carry while touring. It has a lot of helpful tips and highlights of the main tourist sites.

This guide was a great resource for us when we were in Prague recently. As usual, the Rick Steves guide hits the highlights in a form factor that's easy to carry.

I used these guides all through Prague, much better than taking those guided walking tours with 50 people. I got to learn just as much (maybe more) at my own pace. It's a small size so i could tuck it into a pocket. My only quibble is that when you open and close it enough pages start falling out, so it could use a better binding glue.

This was a great book, and helped my wife and I find lots of hidden gems on our trip to Prague. We love Rick Steve's shows and his books are just as good!

My wife and I used this a perfect guide for our 3.5 days in Prague. Just take the book with you and walk the town to see the sights.
